

# O'O'P Information needed to open a Fiduciary Account

## **Fiduciary Accounts**

#### Representative Payee

- Letter from Social Security Administration appointing Representative Payee or a copy of the Social Security Check listing the payee
- Personal information on Beneficiary and Representative Payee
  - o Name
  - Date of birth
  - o Physical address
    - Proof of address may be required if it is not up to date on your ID
  - Mailing address (if applicable)
  - Tax ID Number for both the Social Security beneficiary and the Rep Payee
  - Valid Government Issued ID (i.e. driver's license, state identification card, military id, etc.) for the Rep Payee
  - o Phone Number and email address (if applicable)

### Fiduciary for Veteran Benefits

- Letter from Veteran Affairs appointing Fiduciary
- Personal information on Beneficiary and Fiduciary
  - o Name
  - Date of birth
  - Physical address
    - Proof of address may be required if it is not up to date on your ID
  - Mailing address (if applicable)
  - Tax ID Number for both the VA Benefits beneficiary and the Fiduciary
  - Valid Government Issued ID (i.e. driver's license, state identification card, military id, etc.) for the Fiduciary
  - o Phone Number and email address (if applicable)

#### **Conservator Accounts**

- Court documents appointing:
  - ✓ Conservator,
  - ✓ Plenary Guardian, or
  - ✓ Guardian with Powers over Estate
    - Guardianship documents need to define if the guardianship covers financial
- Personal information on Beneficiary and Fiduciary
  - o Name
  - o Date of birth
  - Physical address
    - Proof of address may be required if it is not up to date on your ID
  - Mailing address (if applicable)
  - Tax ID Number for both the primary member and the Conservator
  - Valid Government Issued ID (i.e. driver's license, state identification card, military id, etc.)
  - Phone Number and email address (if applicable)
